Read Deuteronomy 6:4-7 & Judges 2:10

- What do you notice about these two passages? What must we do first before we can help others know about God?
- Did you have someone in your life who modeled Deuteronomy 6:4-7 for you? If not, how can you be that person for someone else in your life today?

Read Psalm 145:4-7

- Spend some time listing out the attributes of God that you see in this passage.
- Look back at your own life. Where has God been faithful? What would you have told your younger self?
- David says, "Everyone...will sing with joy about your righteousness." Where do you need to infuse joy?

Read 1 Timothy 1:15-16, 4:12

- How is God calling you to be an example of Him to others in your life right now? Where might you be running from this call on your life?
- What might it look like for you to offer a blessing to a young person in your life? How can you speak words of encouragement and life into that person's life?
