Use this time to gather together and get everyone talking. Let your kids know that this is safe place for them to share their feelings, emotions and questions.

- For your elementary-aged kids, ask them about the best part of their week. Allow space for them to share a hard part of their week if they would like.
- For your preschool-aged kids, have them tell you about and draw something fun from their week.
- ASK: What is favorite thing to do together as a family?

ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- READ Romans 12:10 out loud. What does God tell us to do? (Sincerely love each other and be happy to honor each other)

ASK your Preschooler:

- Who was the very first person in our ohana — Adam or Cain? (Adam)
- When Cain did NOT bring his best food, was God happy or sad? (Sad)
- What did Cain do when he was angry —help his brother or hurt his brother? (Hurt his brother) No family is perfect, and sometimes we do wrong things. But God still loves us, even when we do wrong things. And He loves the special family He gave us!

have fun together

From playing to praying together, have fun learning more about God!

- Take some time to pray together as a family. Pray that each person would recognize that your family is a gift from God. None of us are perfect, but He has given us to each other as a gift. Allow your kids to share any prayer requests that they might have and allow your kids to pray out loud if they would like to.
- PLAY “I Spy” by having one person to find an object in the room with their eyes and allow everyone else to guess what the object is that they saw. Once the object is guessed, have everyone to share their answer to the following questions.

-Who are the people that live in your house?

-What is your favorite thing to do with your family?
