## TALK ABOUT IT

- 1** Read **Mark 4:35-41**. What stands out to you about this passage? Describe a time in your life when you identified with the disciples (verse 38)—in a storm, asking God if He cares.
- 2** Jesus performs a miracle and provides a way out of the storm as soon as the disciples cry out to Him. How is this current pandemic forcing you away from self-dependence and toward complete dependence on God?
- 3** Read **Psalm 9:10 and Proverbs 18:10**. Knowing someone by name implies having a relationship with them. How does truly knowing someone relate to your trust in them?
- 4** How can you get to know the character of God better by knowing His many names? [This resource](#) may be helpful. Which of these names describe where you need God most right now?
- 5** Read **2 Corinthians 1:3-4**. When have you experienced God as your comfort? Where else do you tend to run for comfort (health, money, daily routine)? Who has God placed in your life to love well during this time (verse 4)?
