PLAY

- Would you rather only eat candy canes OR only eat Christmas cookies?
- Would you rather have colored Christmas tree lights OR white Christmas tree lights?
- Would you rather build a gingerbread house OR decorate a Christmas tree?
- Would you rather have cookies and milk OR hot chocolate?

Discussion Questions:

- Tell me about a time when you had a hard time believing that God loves you and has good things for you.
- What can help you know that you can believe God?
- What are some things we can believe about God?
