Use this time to gather together and get everyone talking. Let your kids know that this is safe place for them to share their feelings, emotions and questions.

- For your elementary-aged kids, ask them about the best part of their week. Allow space for them to share a hard part of their week if they would like.
- For your preschool-aged kids, have them tell you about and draw something fun from their week.
- ASK: What is favorite dinner to eat together as a family?

ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- READ Galatians 4:6-7 out loud. What does God call us in these verses? (He calls us His children.) We are God's children. He chose us to be His children so that we could be invited into his family.

ASK your Preschooler:

- Who was the very first person in our ohana — Adam or Cain? (Adam)
- When Cain did NOT bring his best food, was God happy or sad? (Sad)
- What did Cain do when he was angry —help his brother or hurt his brother? (Hurt his brother) No family is perfect, and sometimes we do wrong things. But God still loves us, even when we do wrong things. And He loves the special family He gave us!

From playing to praying together, have fun learning more about God!

- Take some time to pray together as a family. Pray that each person would recognize that your family is a gift from God. Pray that each person will choose to be a part of God's family by believing in Him. Allow your kids to share any prayer requests that they might have and allow your kids to pray out loud if they would like to.
- Have a paper plane throwing content.
 - Give everyone a blank piece of paper and crayons or markers to decorate.
 - Have everyone fold their paper however they want and decorate their airplane.
 - Then see who can throw their paper airplane the farthest.
