ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- Explain how to find a verse the Bible. Look up Romans 8:28 and read it together.
- **SAY: This is our Bible verse for this series. We're going to practice saying it so you will have it in your heart to help you remember that God is for you! Say this after me:**

We know that (both hands point to head)

God is always at work (pound fists)

For the good (thumbs to chest)

Of everyone who loves him. (cross arms over chest)

They are the ones (both hands point out)

God has chosen for His purpose. (hands out, palm up)

Romans 8:28 (make book with hands)

ASK your Preschooler:

- **Was Pharaoh nice or mean to God's people?** (mean)

- **Did God talk to Moses from a talking cactus or a burning bush? (burning bush) That's right! God told Moses that He had a special plan for his life. God cared about Moses, and God cares about you!**

have fun together

From playing to praying together, have fun learning more about God!

- Take some time to pray together as a family. Praise God for caring about all aspects of our lives. Repent for those times we may not have cared well for others. Ask God to answer any prayer requests. Say yes to all God has for us.
- **DRAW** together. Get some paper and coloring utensils. Draw yourselves as cowboys and then hang them up around your home to remind yourselves that you are wanted by God because he cares for you.
