ASK your Elementary Schooler:

ASK your Preschooler:

- **Was God all by Himself when He created everything or was Jesus with Him?** (Jesus was with Him)
- **God loved the world so much that He sent who - Bubbles or Jesus?** (Jesus)
- **Who died on the cross to take the punishment for the wrong things we do — you or Jesus?** (Jesus) **Yes! And then Jesus came back to life! How wonderful!**

SAY: Learning about all the things Jesus did fills me with wonder, and there's so much we can learn about Him when we read the Bible!
