*Use this time to gather together and get everyone talking.*

- GIVE everyone a chance to share the best part of their week. If they have a difficult part they'd like to share, allow time for that as well.
- ASK: **If you could pick 3 animals to put together and create a new animal, which animals would you pick? What would it be called?**



## watch

*Watch today's Elementary and/or Preschool video on the webpage where you found this lesson or on the Traders Point Kids YouTube channel.*

ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- **What does God know about your life?** (Everything)
- **What does the Bible tell us about God's thoughts about us?** (They are priceless, they are more than the grains of sand)
- **What is one question you have about your life?**
- **How does knowing God loves you change how you feel every day?**

ASK your Preschooler:

- **In the Bible, did King David say that Sparky or God put us together?** (God)
- **Who does God love more — you and me or the birds and flowers?** (You and me)

**SAY: God loves the birds and flowers, but He loves you even more! When we wonder why God made us, we can remember that He made us because He loves us!**

- With your older kids, PLAY a game of science trivia using these facts below. For your younger kids, help them DRAW the new animal that they would create from the opening question on this guide.
  1. True or False: Space is absolutely silent. (True)
  2. True or False: The moon gives off its own light. (False) The moon doesn't give off any light but reflects the light of the sun.
  3. True or False: Once you eat your food, it takes your body around 12 hours to fully absorb it. (True)
  4. True or False: Pineapples take two years to grow. (True)
  5. True or False: Saturn's rings are made of small bits of glass. (False) Saturn's rings are made of trillions of chunks of ice.
  6. True or False: Your blood is as salty as the ocean. (True)
  7. True or False: There are more grains of sand than there are stars in the sky. (False) There are more stars.
  8. True or False: A fox uses its tail to talk to other foxes. (True)
  9. True or False: Toenails grow faster than fingernails. (False) Fingernails grow four times faster than toenails.
  10. True or False: Elephants are the only animals who can't jump. (True)
  11. True or False: It's impossible to sneeze with your eyes open. (True)
