- **Read <u>Isaiah 50:4-5</u>**. What do you think it takes to truly hear God's words of wisdom, and how can you use that to keep the thorns away from the seed? Have you had a time where you saw heart transformation from intentionally seeking God's Word?
- **Read Ezekiel 36:25-27.** What does God use to help the Israelites in their half-heartedness?
- **Read <u>John 14:26</u>.** When do you see the Spirit in your own life? When was the last time you intentionally sought out the Spirit to reveal God's teaching to you?
