- ASK: What is your favorite game to play with your family?

ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- READ James 5:13-16 out loud.
 - When did these verses say we should pray? (When you are suffering hardships, happy, sick, or have committed a sin.)
 - Look at verse 16 again. Who does it say you should pray for? (each other.)
 - What are some specific prayers you could say for people in your family? (Help us all get along, keep us safe when we are traveling, help them when they are sick, etc.)

ASK your Preschooler:

- Did Peter see seashells or animals on the sheet in his dreams? (Animals)
- Did Peter run away from Cornelius or go to his house? (Went to his house)
- How did Cornelius' family feel to hear Peter tell them about Jesus happy or mad? (happy)
 God showed Peter that HE loves everyone and wants us to love everyone, too! God loves you and He loves your family.
