## circle up

Use this time to gather together and get everyone talking.

- GIVE everyone a chance to share the best part of their week. If they have a difficult part they'd like to share, allow time for that as well.
- ASK: Would you rather be a scientist that studies planets in outer space or animals from the deep ocean? Why?



## watch

ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- What is one question you have about miracles?
- Where do you think you can find answers to your questions? (Talk to God, look in the Bible, ask an adult)
- What did you learn about miracles in today's lesson?
- What is a miracle you would like to see in your life?

ASK your Preschooler:

- Who has the power to do miracles God or Sparky? (God)
- Did God give Jesus the power to walk on water or on pudding? (Water)

SAY: God has the power to do anything, and when we wonder about His powerful miracles, we can read about them in the Bible! Then we will be filled with amazement!

## have fun together

From playing to praying together, have fun learning more about God!

- If the weather permits, take some time to be outside together. You can go for a walk or play in your backyard. As you enjoy nature together, encourage your kids to look around and point out things that were miraculously made by God. You can share that nature allows us to wonder more about God and can help us see how big He is. You can also sit outside at night underneath the stars and talk about how God made the entire universe. Have your kids find pictures or patterns in the stars and wonder together about how God designed all of it so perfectly.
- PRAY together as a family. Ask for any prayer requests from your kids. Encourage them to pray out loud if they feel comfortable doing so. You can use this prayer as a guide if you'd like: Hey God! Thank you for being a powerful God who can do anything! Help us to always trust You and know that You can perform miracles in our lives! We love You! Amen!
