WATCH TODAY'S MESSAGE

As a family, watch today's Preschool Message from our website or YouTube. Keep the conversation going while doing the activities listed below.

Materials Needed: Christmas items, bag

DO

- Without your family seeing, place a Christmas item (candy cane, ornament, etc.) inside a bag.
- Show the bag to your family.
- Pass the bag and allow each family member to guess what is in the bag.
- Then take out the item and show everyone what was is in the bag.
- Repeat with new items, allowing different members of the family to take turns choosing what item goes in the bag.

PLAY

Say: We're going SING a song together called, J-E-S-U-S (to the tune of "B-I-N-G-O"):

God gave us a gift [There was a farmer]

Too great for words, [who had a dog]

And Jesus is His name-o! [And Bingo was his name-o]

J-E-S-U-S! [B-I-N-G-0]

Sing the song a few times and have your child help make up some hand motions. Talk about these discussion questions in between singing:

- What is your favorite part about Christmas?
- Did God send an angel to tell Mary she would have a special party or a special baby? (Special baby)
- Did Mary and Elizabeth think God can do anything? (Yes) Yes! God can do anything!
